

## Fame Production Team Information

We provide the following information in response to questions about this years production which have been brought to our attention.

This production will be presented at the 76ers game on March 26; in all three recitals and compete at Faces of the Future in June. These performances are mandatory. The production will be the opening number, and those not in any additional numbers are not required to stay, or purchase tickets unless they plan to stay and watch the show. There are a few optional opportunities for this group: These include Beach Ball (Wildwood) in July of 2010 and Orlando in October 2010, along with other opportunities (Community events) as they present themselves.

Costumes for this number were assigned at the auditions. Please keep in mind when choosing your outfit that dancers must be able to perform in these outfits. All alterations should be made so the dancer does not feel the need to "adjust" while performing on stage. The outfits should look clean, pressed and "fresh". Use accessories to make the outfits complete and to accent their clothing. Feel free to accent with rhinestones, hats (must be secure), belts, or graffiti(only if suitable). Dancers may wear jazz shoes or sneakers of any color or style. Hair and Make-up must be done as this is a performance. We want a complete, polished and professional look; no one should be wrinkled, dirty or messy in appearance.

At auditions, each dancer was assigned a group. Based on that assignment you should select your costume.

Grade School: Preppy look/ School uniform look

use plaids or solid color dress shirts, vest, skirts (must have trunks or leotard underneath), or dress shorts with knee socks. Boys should wear baggy cargo pants in black or tan with a dress shirt and vest. Hair styles include pig tails or braids, using ribbons as accents.

Middle School – Three options (Nerd, Sports look, Sassy Pre-Teen)

- o Nerd- Colors do not match. Flood pants belted high. Glasses, Solids and stripes together.
- o Sports – Basketball player, Golfer, Softball, Tennis, Cheerleader
- o Sassy Pre-Teen – Hanna Montana look. Must look age, not older.

High School- Five options (Dancer, Urban, Goth, Rocker, Hollister)

- o Dancer – body suit with leg warmers, dance shorts. Full out look the role.
- o Urban – Baggy hip hop pants, vest, graphic t-shirt
- o Goth – Black pants, black shirt (think Hot Topic)
- o Rocker – Punk look. Wild colors. Piercing and Colored hair.
- o Hollister – Beach look shorts and shirt or Capri pants and t-shirt.

ALL Costumes need to be approved by Ms. Staci ONLY. All dancers are REQUIRED to bring/wear their costumes to the Feb 27<sup>th</sup> practice. There are no exceptions. Once an outfit is approved, no changes can be made.

As a reminder, all ticket money is due on Jan 9<sup>th</sup>. All dancers must have a ticket to get into the arena. You DO NOT have to purchase 5 tickets, we are LIMITING the number of tickets a dancer can purchase to 5, since we have only 200 seats available. Our seats are club box and lower level. Upper seats are available to those not staying after our performance. We will make an announcement if seats remain available after each dancer has placed their orders for those who may desire more then five for family or friends.
